The Grinnell College Museum of Art staff continue to be available to support teaching across the curriculum. Kay Wilson [wilsonka@grinnell.edu] can help faculty identify works in the collection that you can use in your online teaching for class discussions, visual literacy projects, or assignments. We can create portfolios of images for you and make them available through BB Collaborate or other platforms.

Tilly Woodward [woodward@grinnell.edu] or I [wrightL@grinnell.edu] can work with faculty to design a class session using the collection, or around any other visual materials. We are always happy to brainstorm a lesson, an assignment, or a project for individual students.

For example, we are working with Josh Marshack in Anthropology to support both his classes right now. Tilly is providing images and discussion leadership about images of war for Josh's advanced class on War, Peace and Human Nature. I'm doing a close looking and description exercise with his Intro class using African art objects in the collection.

Please be thinking about the collection as a way to add variety this spring (not that you need to add anything at this point) and to enrich your classes next fall, in person or online. We look forward to working with you!
